On 12 December 2015, Fr Trovia Lui will be coming to our parish, St Paul the Apostle, as Assistant Priest.

Fr Trovia was born in Samoa. He was ordained a priest on 8 December 1983, for the Archdiocese of Samoa-Apia.

Fr Trovia earned a licentiate degree on Moral Theology in the Academia Alfonsiana, Rome.

In 1995, he was appointed chaplain for the Samoan Catholics in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. In 2004, he was incardinated to the Archdiocese of Los Angeles.

Fr Trovia has asked to take a leave from the Archdiocese of Los Angeles to exercise active ministry in the Diocese of Parramatta, where most members of his family reside.

#### Celebrate the Second Week of Advent

We light the second purple candle on the second Sunday of Advent to represent the hope of Christ coming to the world. The word "hope" has two meanings in the Bible. The first, *tiqvah*, contains the sense of eager anticipation or waiting. The second, *elpis*, depicts a sense of confident expectation based on certainty. Biblical hope is secured by God's faithfulness to His promises. For the Old Testament leaders, their hope was in the Messiah's arrival. For us, it is the hope of the Messiah's return.

God's plan for humanity unfolded in the town of Bethlehem, the birthplace of the messiah, joyously fulfilling a long-awaited promise. Today we confidently await the messiah's triumphant return.

"But you, Bethlehem, only a small village in Judah, yet a ruler of Israel will come from you, one whose origins are from a distant past... And He will stand to lead His flock with the Lord's strength... Then His people will live undisturbed, for he will be highly honoured around the world. And he will be the source of our peace." (Micah 5:2, 4-5)

This is one of the most powerful messianic passages because Bethlehem is pinpointed as the birthplace of the Messiah. Written 750 years before Christ, the prophet Micah tells of the honour which will belong to Bethlehem. Christ's deity and humanity are shown here – He is a shepherd, leading with the strength of God, bringing peace to His people.

The precision of God's promises proclaimed and fulfilled inspire us continually to hope in God. The hope of Christians is wishful thinking, but based on the historical facts of Christ's birth, death and resurrection, and in the confidence of His eagerly anticipate return.
