FROM FATHER RANING


Last year, a woman contributed the following real-life anecdote to the New York Times weekly "Metropolitan Diary" column:

Dear Diary: It was a day when the threat of rain hung in the air. I drove up to a drive-through market in Stony Brook, L.I., to buy milk and was waited on by a man wearing a turban. Handing me my change through the car window, he said, with the trace of an Indian accent, "Ah! The smell of eternity is in the air."

I was impressed, assuming his mystical words were either the Indian equivalent of "It feels like rain," or a philosophical observation akin to "The end is near." I smiled politely and said nothing. But he continued. "Eternity," he repeated. "Aren't you wearing Eternity cologne?"

Today is Easter Sunday and the smell of eternity is in the air. Christ is risen! Death is overcome!

Easter is the greatest and the most important feast in the Church. "Easter" literally means "the feast of fresh flowers." We celebrate it with pride and jubilation for several reasons.



The resurrection of Christ is the basis of our Christian faith, because it is the greatest of the miracles to prove that Jesus is God. That is why St Paul writes: "If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain; and your faith is in vain... And if Christ has not been raised, then your faith is a delusion and you are still lost in your sins..." (I Cor 15:14.17, 20)

2. Easter is the guarantee of our own resurrection. Jesus assured Martha at the tomb of Lazarus: "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me will live even though he dies". (Jn 11:25-26)

Easter is a great mystery. How do we look at the Resurrection of the Lord Jesus?

Years ago, Larry, an old municipal lamplighter, engaged in putting out his lights one by one, was met by a reporter who asked him if he ever grew tired of his work in the cold dark night. "Never am I cheerless," said the old man, "for there is always a light ahead of me to lead me on." "But what do you have to cheer up when you have put out the last light?" asked the news writer. "Then comes the dawn," said Larry, the lamplighter.
