## FROM FATHER RANING

There's a fat, wily little cat named Garfield who's the star of a popular comic strip. In an instalment, Garfield is shown curled up in his cozy chair with a can of beer in his hand and watching TV, while outside a fierce storm is raging. Through the window Garfield sees one of his buddies, just standing there shivering, freezing to death with icicles hanging from his nose. Garfield is overcome with emotion, and exclaims, "I can't just sit here and watch him freeze. I've got to do something!" And with that he jumps up, runs to the window, and closes the blinds!

Garfield is not alone. Drawing the drapes and closing the blinds on ugly reality is not reserved just for the comics. In every one of us there's a little voice that speaks up when we're faced with evil, and that voice says, "What you're looking at is too much for you, so you'd better run." It's the voice of fear, and very often we listen to it, and run. Fear makes us run from what's ugly or sinister or wrong outside us and around us. It also makes us run from the dark and broken parts of ourselves.

Today's gospel makes it clear that God has an alternative for us. On a Sabbath evening, right in the synagogue, Jesus sees an evil spirit that has some poor man in its total control. (We should note that the Jews use that term "evil spirit" to refer to anything evil that could take over a person's life and possess him or own him.) So Jesus sees the "evil spirit" and he doesn't look away. He confronts it, "Be quiet, and get out!" he says. "Have no more power over this man," and that's exactly what happens. The man is set free.

That is God's desire for us, and he has the power to make it happen if we will trust him enough to open our eyes, name what needs to be named, and put it all in his hands.

Jesus' mastery of unclean spirits shows he is reordering the world.


