## FROM FATHER RANING

*What wisdom have I found most valuable for my daily guidance?*

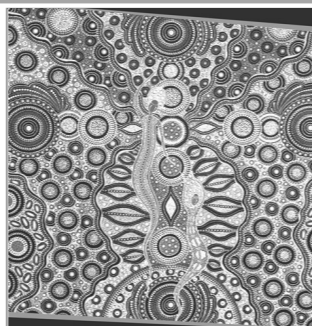
Second Reading: God's word can penetrate deep into our inner self and reveal things we might not want to see.
