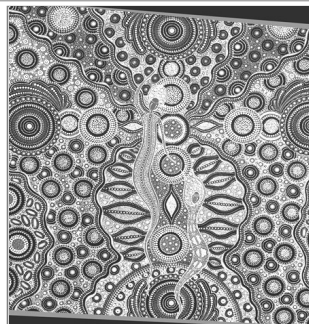

The Plenary Council is held in three stages:

Preparation, celebration and implementation.

Preparation is currently ongoing until the first session of the Council. Celebration of the Council will be the two sessions being held in October 2020 in Adelaide and in May 2021 in Sydney. Implementation is the ongoing life of the Church and her people after the Plenary Council session. Preparation for the Plenary Council begins with open Listening and Dialogue. It is the first step to preparing the agenda for the Plenary Council.

On Saturday, 17 November 2018 at 2:00 PM at **Fr David Scott Centre** our parish will commence small groups for the Listening and Dialogue Encounters. These will function in a similar way to Lenten groups.
