From Father Raining

At Washington National Airport, a long line had formed at one of the airline ticket windows. Suddenly, a strange-looking character charged up to the front of the line, put ten dollars on the counter and said to the ticket agent, "I want to go to New York." The clerk said, "I'm sorry sir, but you can't go to New York for ten dollars." "Well where can I go?" the man asked. Then fourteen people in the line told him where to go.

The Easter Message is telling us where to go. The Risen Christ is telling us that the waiting is over, the death-watch is over. The time has come for us to follow Jesus through death into life. The time has come for us to roll away the stone and rise from the tomb of our empty life.

In the year 1513 A.D., Italian artist Fra Giovanni wrote this letter to a friend who was desperately looking for meaning in his life:

"I salute you. I am your friend and my love for you goes deep. There is nothing I can give you which you have not got; but there is much, very much, that while I cannot give it to you, you can take.



No heaven can come to us unless our hearts find rest in today. Take Heaven! No peace lies in the future which is not hidden in this present little instance. Take Peace. The gloom of the world is but a shadow. Behind it, within reach is Joy. There is a radiance and glory in the darkness could we but see-and to see we have only to look. I beseech you to look!"

Look for the Lord. But not in the tomb, for He is not there. The tomb is empty. The Lord is Risen and He resides deep within your soul. Find Him there, and you will clearly see, that He lives deep within your neighbour's soul as well.

First Reading: Peter summarises the Christian motive for mission: when we experience the risen Christ, we proclaim this message to others.
How might I share my belief in Jesus' resurrection with others today?

Second Reading: Our connection to the risen Christ influences all our behaviour.
What is the biggest change that Christ's presence to me this Lent has made in my life?

Gospel: The risen Christ is always present with us but not always noticed.
How can I be more attentive to Christ's presence now?
