From Father Raining

A faculty member of a large University was struggling with many fears. He feared that his marriage was coming apart. He feared that his career as a teacher and a scientist was floundering. He feared for his children's future in the kind of world they would be inheriting. And so he took to drinking heavily, until he was confronted with all the fears of an alcoholic. He awakened one morning in his automobile out on a lonely country road, and hadn't the slightest idea how he got there.

That in itself was terrifying: "How long was I driving in that condition? Have I reached a point of no return in my life?" He said that in the midst of all these fears, he cried out to Christ, "If You exist, if You are there, please come and help me." There were no bright lights, there were no dramatic visions, but in that moment, he felt a sense of calm within himself. He said, "Somehow I knew that this was the turning point." And so it was.

"And there was a great calm." And the disciples "were filled with awe, and said to one another, 'Who then is this, that even the wind and sea obey him?'"

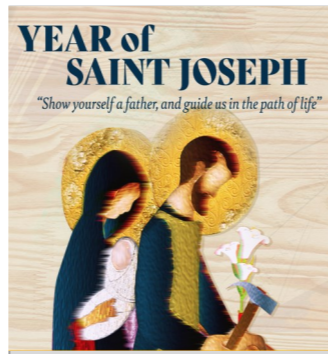
First Reading: What does it mean to be in a new creation in Christ?
