# Message from our Priest - Important update and changes to Mass times

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

On Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> June at the 9am Mass, I announced that I was reviewing our livestreaming arrangements. Thank you for your constructive feedback given to me regarding livestreaming of our parish Masses. After consultation with our Parish Pastoral Council at our meeting on Monday of this week, please note the following outcomes below.

#### **Effective immediately**

- Daily Rosary continues unchanged at 8:40am Monday to Saturday, however will not be livestreamed
- Monday to Friday Morning Mass at 9:10am will continue to be livestreamed, except where students from St Paul the Apostle Primary School will be in attendance (noting that school Masses are typically on a Friday during school terms).
- Saturday morning Mass will be celebrated at 9:10am instead of 9:00am (and will be livestreamed). This is to align with the same time as all our weekday Masses. Most importantly will give everyone the appropriate time needed to silently and spiritually prepare for Mass especially after praying of the Holy Rosary.

#### **Effective August 2023**

 Commencing 3<sup>rd</sup> August, weeknight Mass will be reintroduced on Thursdays. Adoration will occur at 6:00pm with prayers and intentions for our parish youth and vocations, followed by Mass at 7:00pm.

If you are physically able to attend Mass, please come and join us, as our fellow parishioners would love to see you, and above all so that you are able to physically encounter our Lord Jesus Christ fully present in the Holy Eucharist.

Thank you for your understanding. May God bless and guide our parish always! St Paul the Apostle; pray for us!

The hearing loop provides a magnetic, wireless signal that is picked up by the hearing aid when it is set to 'T' (Telecoil) setting.

# Safeguarding, Training and Rosters: Important update for our volunteers and ministers

Safeguarding Training is a way of "ensuring children and vulnerable adults under our care are safe, protected and enabled to flourish". It is a requirement volunteers across our ministries are to complete this training in order to perform and continue in their role.

This is a Diocesan directive and necessary in order to fulfill just some of the obligations across all parishes to ensure appropriate efforts are being made in this area. A big thank you to everyone who has responded and completed their Mandatory Safeguarding Training. If you have not already started this training, it is imperative to commence as a matter of priority.

For those unable to complete training on a computer, or prefer to do it in a group environment, our parish has organised face to face sessions to be held in the Father David Scott Parish Centre during the month of July.
