Message from our Priest

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

Greetings with the love and peace of our Lord Jesus Christ.

In joyful news, 70 children are about to begin preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation in our parish I am grateful to their parents in continually fulfilling their solemn promise when these children were baptised; that they will bring them up to keep the two commandments: to love God, and to love another. Parents, as part of their ongoing faith formation, need to be fully equipped in their sacred duty as the first teachers of their children's faith journey. To facilitate this process, there are parent only sessions which are a vital component and will be held on the 13th and 14th September.

The Sacrament of Confirmation, together with the Sacraments of Baptism and Eucharist constitute the "Sacraments of Christian Initiation". Confirmation is necessary for the completion of baptismal grace (CCC 1285). The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us that "Confirmation perfects Baptismal grace; it is the sacrament which gives the Holy Spirit in order to root us more deeply in the divine filiation, incorporate us more firmly into Christ, strengthen our bond with the Church, associate us more closely with her mission, and help us bear witness to the Christian faith in words accompanied by deeds" (CCC 1316).

I am inviting all of you, our fellow parishioners, to keep these children and their families in our prayers so that the Holy Spirit will guide them to have a deeper and meaningful relationship with Jesus and with each other. Please also pray for those who give up generously of their time in the Sacramental team.

St Paul the Apostle; pray for us! May God bless our parish always!
