The St Vincent de Paul Society is a lay catholic organisation founded 1833 in France which is now active in 150 countries with over 800,000 members and 1,500,000 volunteers supporting the poor and vulnerable, and works to shape a just and compassionate society. In Australia, the Society was founded in 1854 and commonly known as 'Vinnies' and today has over 45,000 members and volunteers across the country.

Our membership is primarily Catholic and our work based on Catholic Social Teachings. We assist whoever seeks our support, without judgement or prejudice. We do not discriminate against cultural, religious, political, gender or gender identity beliefs. We work to combat social injustice by advocating for people who are marginalised or disadvantaged, or at risk of experiencing disadvantage. Our advocacy work goes to the heart of what the St Vincent de Paul Society stands for.

Our Winston Hills conference started in 1972 at a time where care was to the needler people in the developing Mount Druitt area and still do to this day. Our conference comprises of six active members who meet for prayer, spiritual reflection and to review the home visits.
