## Saint Vincent de Paul Winter Appeal - St Paul the Apostle Parish

Every day at Vinnies, we see that ordinary people are able to make an extraordinary difference in their communities. We are inspired by the joy of the Gospels and Catholic Social Teachings to do things that matter. The spirit to feed, heal, shelter, nurture and inspire – the power to change lives is in everyone. At Vinnies we do more than offer a hand out – we offer a hand up.

This has been a particularly cold and wet winter at a time when many people are struggling with the rising cost of living and finding a safe place to live. Calls for assistance have increased for all Vinnies services. Our conference conducts home visits for people living both in our Parish and in the Mount Druitt area while two of our members also assist at the Harris Park and Emerton Vinnies Community Support Centres. Although food remains the most common request for assistance, we also provide white goods, furniture, blankets and clothing to those in need. More recently, we have been teaming up with other Conferences to provide assistance to refugee families in urgent need. Finally, many of the people we assist are socially isolated so our time to sit and chat is often just as important as the material assistance of food and clothing.

We cannot do this alone. This winter your commitment to helping those experiencing disadvantage, poverty, loneliness and homelessness is still needed and very much appreciated. Saint Pauls' parishioners have always been very generous in supporting the work of conference members and we look forward to this continuing. Thank you from us and thank you from those we assist.
