Important change: prayers for the deceased during Mass

The love and remembrance for those that have gone before us is evident with the many requests we receive for the names of our loved ones to be read during the Prayer of the Faithful, or Universal Prayer. The intention of this Prayer is to be expressive of the prayer of the entire community (as per the General Instruction of the Roman Missal - GIRM). As you are aware, the list of those that are deceased can be quite lengthy and may not always be known to the majority of those assembled. Being mindful of the intention of the GIRM, the Prayer of the Faithful will be limited to those that are recently deceased. This change will commence on the first weekend of October. If your intention is to acknowledge an anniversary of the deceased, or a similar significant date, their name can be included at a specific Mass of your choice during the week or weekend, however not all Masses. There is no change to the existing process of including names in our bulletin with all requests to be submitted by Wednesday afternoon.
