Rite of Blessing for our new Church Monstrance this Friday, February 6th

At the end of 2024, with your generous support, the parish received \$7,505 in donations from our fellow parishioners to purchase a new monstrance to use during our weekly and monthly 24-hour Adoration. I was unable to purchase a new one immediately due to some circumstances that I had to face personally and pastorally last year. In good news for our parish I wish to inform you that finally I was able to purchase the new monstrance.

I will bless the monstrance during the 9:10am Mass this Friday, February 6th and encourage and invite everyone to attend if they are available. The 24 Hour Eucharistic Adoration will follow immediately afterwards and again you are invited to stay awhile in prayerful contemplation in the company of our Lord.

I am grateful again for your generous financial and prayerful support in purchasing this new monstrance.

Ash Wednesday - we need your blessed palms

The specific "newness" of ash to be used is not strictly mandated in the Code of Canon Law however it is established liturgical practice that ashes are to be prepared from the palms blessed in the preceding year. In order to have sufficient quantities of ashes, we kindly ask to please bring in your blessed palms so they can be burnt in time for Ash Wednesday and can be placed in the box in the church foyer. Please note this is call out for dried palms and not fresh palms (which are used for Palm Sunday). Thank you.

Saturday Mass of the Virgin Mary

The Saturday Mass of the Virgin Mary is a devotional, optional memorial celebrated on Saturdays in Ordinary Time when no other obligatory memorial falls on that day. It honours the Blessed Virgin Mary, often highlighting her role in salvation history or, in some seasons like Advent, focusing on her as the Mother of God. Saturdays are traditionally dedicated to Mary in the Catholic Church, a practice that allows for the veneration of the Blessed Virgin through a specific Mass or Office.

This Saturday, February 7th will be the last occasion for this memorial until Saturday May 30th being the first Saturday in Pentecost.
