Clergy Update in our parish

Clergy on leave

Father John Paul, as you may be aware, continues to be overseas to be with his mother in hospital care. At this stage Father is expected to return from the Philippines next weekend or thereabouts. We continue to pray for his mother Paloma and their family at this difficult time.

Father Jobi who is currently on leave will be expected to return from India towards the end of this month.

During their period of leave we continue to be grateful to Father Pio and visiting priests in ensuring that our liturgies and other ministries continue to be celebrated without disruption, including visitations to local nursing homes which the clergy of our parish currently undertake four times per month.

Changes to clergy appointed to our parish

In terms of background, Clergy appointments in the Diocese of Parramatta are typically for a term of six years for parish priests. Assistant Priests terms can vary, being for a set period or at the Bishop's discretion, and is not uncommon for changes to appointments before their agreed term has ended.

Father Jobi was appointed in our parish in May 2025 and Father Pio in July 2025 and we are indeed deeply grateful for their ministry and time and will certainly be missed. Once finalised, details about their final Mass(es) will be made known to the parish.
