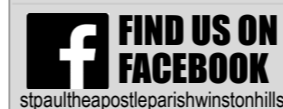

Granting of Plenary Indulgence by Pope Francis

In order to assist you in fulfilling the requirements of this Indulgence, a statue of Our Lady of Fatima will be exposed in the Marian Chapel.

“The faithful, with devotion, can visit Our Lady during the days of the anniversary of the apparitions, the 13th of each month from May to October 2017, and there devoutly participate in some celebration or prayer in honour of the Virgin Mary. In addition, the faithful must pray the Our Father, recite the Creed and invoke Our Lady of Fatima. In order to obtain plenary indulgences, the faithful who are truly repentant and filled with charity must fulfil the following ritual conditions; sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father.”
