## St Paul's Primary Enrolment

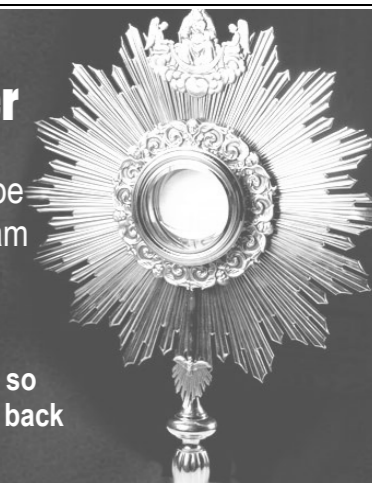
